Fundraising on JustGiving



Thank you for running to support Barons Court Project! We really are incredibly grateful to have supporters like you standing with us and our guests.

Setting up your fundraising campaign on JustGiving couldn't be easier. To start, go to:
justgiving.com/create-page

The sign up process is quick and straightforward. The key points are:

- You will need to log in to your existing JustGiving account or create a new account if you don't already have one (which is also a straightforward process).
- When asked "Are you raising money for a charity", choose "Yes, I'm fundraising for a charity", then search for and select Barons Court Project as your chosen charity.
- We are asking our runners to commit to raising a minimum of £100, but you can set your fundraising target as high as you think you will be able to raise. Supporters can keep sponsoring after you've reached your target, but a higher target can encourage people to give more.

While setting up your fundraising campaign, you will be asked to provide a short story about why you are running and what you are raising money for. If you would like to, you can write personally about what Barons Court Project means to you, or feel free to use the short blurb below to help highlight your reason for running:

I'm excited to take part in the Santa in the City Run to raise funds for Barons Court Project! My goal is to raise £XXX to help the Project to continue its vital work with those experiencing homelessness and those living with mental health conditions.
